4. Eligibility

- Shishyas must be pursuing/holding an Ayurvedacharya degree.

5. Accommodation and Living Arrangements

- Shishyas are responsible for making their own arrangements for lodging and boarding near their Guru's location.
- Students are required to arrange their own food facility.

6. Attendance and Punctuality

- Shishyas are expected to attend all clinical/theory sessions regularly and on time.

7. Behavior and Demeanor

- Shishyas should behave with dignity and courtesy at all times.

8. Confidentiality

- Shishyas are expected to maintain confidentiality regarding their Guru's teachings, methods, and patient information.

9. Respect for Property

- Shishyas must respect the institution's property and equipment.

10. Health and Hygiene

- Shishyas must maintain good health and hygiene practices.

11. Adherence to Rules

- Strictly adhere to the rules and regulations of the Shishya program.

12. Termination

- The Guru reserves the right to terminate the Shishya program for any student who fails to comply with the rules and regulations.
